## FACULTY



**Mr Wasim Lodhi** (MRCOG PGCert ME) is a consultant obstetrician and gynaecologist from North Middlesex University Hospital with a special interest in outpatient operative hysteroscopy. He has a postgraduate certificate in Medical Education and is his trust's undergraduate lead. He is a co-organiser of the RCOG Masterclass in Massive Obstetric Haemorrhage and has facilitated at Harassment and Undermining workshops nationally. He is heavily involved with the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists and is the current National Convenor of BPS as well as acting Chairperson of the RCOG Pakistan Liaison Group. He is faculty member of the RCOG MRCOG parts I and II courses as well as being an examiner of the new MRCOG part III course. He is a founder trustee of Haemorrhage After Childbirth Foundation, a charity dedicated to teaching skills to doctors and midwives on how to manage obstetric haemorrhage.



**Dr Amina Butt** (MBBCh MRCOG PGCert Gynaecology USS) is a consultant Obstetrician and Gynaecologist from Sulaiman Al Habib Hospital, Riyadh, Saudi Arabia with a special interest in Maternal Medicine and Medical Education. She is the lead for Medical Education in her current hospital as well as RCOG mentor for

Maternal Medicine Fellowship at King Fahad Medical Centre, Riyadh. She is the Saudi Arabia convenor for RCOG Basic Practical Skills Course in Riyadh. She is also the convenor for RCOG Enhanced Revision Programme for MRCOG Part 2 in Saudi Arabia and was a faculty member of the recent Advanced Workshop for Massive Obstetrics Haemorrhage in Riyadh. She has ATSM in Medical Education (RCOG) and has been the Undergraduate Lead for Mid Yorkshire NHS Trust in the UK in 2014.



**Mr Mahantesh Karoshi** (MRCOG, Diploma in Clinical Risk Management) is a consultant Obstetrician and Gynaecologist from Barnet/Royal Free Hospital NHS Trust. Since 2013, he has been a Co-Convenor for the Annual Masterclass in the Management of Massive Obstetric Haemorrhage at the RCOG, London. He graduated in 1994 in India, undertook specialist training in the United Kingdom, and was appointed Consultant Obstetrician and Gynaecologist in 2010. He was a Clinical Research Fellow in Reproductive Medicine Unit at the Fertility Unit of North Middlesex University Hospital and was a Research Associate in 2004 at Northwestern University's Multiple Births Foundation in Chicago, with Professor Louis Keith. In 2010, Royal College of Obstetricians & Gynaecologists, London awarded him the prestigious Bernhard Baron Travelling Fellowship, which allowed him work in the University of Buenos Aires, Argentina, with Professor Jose Palacios on the techniques involved in the advanced surgical management of morbidly adherent placental disorders. He has also co-edited four major textbooks on Obstetrics & Gynaecology with Professor Louis Keith and Professor B-Lynch, including the landmark "Textbook of Postpartum Haemorrhage", a significant contribution to knowledge and practice worldwide in this field. In 2009, his textbook "Obesity and Pregnancy" won the 'Highly Commended' Award at the British Medical Association Book Awards. He is a founder trustee of Haemorrhage After Childbirth Foundation, a charity dedicated to teaching skills to doctors and midwives on how to manage obstetric haemorrhage.



**Mr Wai Yoong** (MBBCh Belf, MD London, FRCOG UK) is a consultant Obstetrician and Urogynaecologist at North Middlesex University Hospital London and an Honorary Senior Lecturer at University College London and Associate Professor at St George's International School of Medicine. In 2014, he was awarded the Sims Black Travelling Professorship by the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists to teach Basic Surgical Skills and PPH management in Jordan. He received his general O&G training in Birmingham and London and completed a Urogynaecology Fellowship in Sydney, Australia. He was also Clinical Research Fellow at the Royal Free Hospital, London and was awarded his MD degree by the University of London. His special interests are pelvic floor surgery, day case vaginal hysterectomy, neuromodulation for overactive bladder syndrome, surgical management of postpartum haemorrhage, hysteroscopic sterilisation and Human Factors in healthcare. He is the senior organiser of the RCOG Masterclass in Management of Massive Obstetric Haemorrhage and senior founder trustee of Haemorrhage After Childbirth Foundation, a charity dedicated to teaching skills to doctors and midwives on how to manage obstetric haemorrhage. He has recently finished his tenure as the RCOG National Convenor of Basic Practical Skills Course and is an Associate Editor for the Journal of Obstetrics and Gynaecology. He leads a team of clinicians partnering with British Airways Flight Training to deliver a collaborative aviation-healthcare Human Factors training course using flight simulators and interactive facilitation to reduce medical errors. He has published 115 papers in peer review journals on subjects such as vaginal surgery, surgical management of PPH, neuromodulation and enhanced recovery.
