

NESOG Orations, Honors, Awards and Medals

ORATIONS

1. NESOG ORATION

Nepal Society of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists (NESOG) is very happy to establish this prestigious ORATION with a medal, to be awarded to a distinguished Invited Speaker at the time of NESOG's Conference annually. The aim of the NESOG Oration is to honor Eminent International and National Obstetricians and Gynaecologists during the National and International NESOG conferences; hence the oration is delivered every year.

2. NESOG/SHREE HIRANANDA VAIDYA MEMORIAL LECTURE

NESOG/Shree Hirananda Vaidya Memorial Lecture was instituted in the year 1998, by Prof. Dr. Sanumaiya Dali, is in the memory of her father, late Shree Hirananda Vaidya, a reputed Medical Practitioner. During his career spanning more than four decades since 1930's, he was popular for his surgical skills, particularly at a time when modern medicine was still in its infancy in Nepal. He was a strong advocate of education of Girl Child even at the time when education was at the reach of royal and higher-class families. Mr. Vaidya was a true philanthropist of his time.

3. NESOG/SHREE CHUDA NANDA VAIDYA ORATION

NESOG/Shree Chuda Nananda Vaidya Memorial Oration was instituted in the year 2007, by Dr. Sushila Baidya Shrestha and her family, is in the memory of her father, late Shree Chuda Nanda Vaidya, a reputed Nepali figure. Born in Kathmandu in B.S. 1972, Mr Vaidya was a renowned scholar, popular teacher and a very successful administrator, manager and a dedicated social worker of his time. He started his career as teacher in Nepal's historical Durbar High School. Later, he was actively involved in bringing up to public the first historical Government Budget in 1955 under the premiership of Matrika Prasad Koirala. As the President of Paropakar Anathalaya, Mr. Vaidya opened its own orphanage and also contributed to

establishment of Paropakar Shree Panch Indra Rajya Laxmi Devi Prasuti Griha in Thapathali, the present Paropakar Maternity and Women's Hospital.

4. NESOG/JUNE THAPA ORATION

NESOG/ June Thapa Oration was instituted in the year 1998, by Prof. Dr. Lok Bikram Thapa and his family, is in the name of Prof. Dr. June Thapa, a reputed obstetrician-gynecologist and academician of Nepal. Born in Palpa in 1936, Prof. Thapa was deeply inspired by her father Shri Shyam Krishna Malla, a reputed medical practitioner of his time.

Prof. Thapa completed her undergraduate medical education at the Lady Hardinge Medical College, New Delhi, India in 1961. Trained in Laparoscopic Sterilization, she led laparoscopic sterilization camps in various parts of Nepal performing **over 40,000 cases** in total and **108 cases in a single day!** She headed the department of Obstetrics-Gynecology at Patan Hospital (1994-2000) and then later Kathmandu Medical College (2001-2007) as a professor.

GOLD MEDAL

1. NESOG /Shri Meenakshi Narayan Memorial Gold Medal

Shri Meenakshi Narayan Memorial Gold medal and certificate is named after the parents of Prof. Saraswati M. Padhye. It was established in year 2008. This medal is given to the Ayurvedic Doctor who stands first in the final examination of TU/IOM Ayurvedic campus, Kirtipur. This medal is awarded in **the International NESOG Conference**, which takes place every two years, and so two doctors are awarded.

AWARDS

1. SOMA Award

SOMA Award was started in the year 2000 with support from Emeritus Prof. Hiroaki Soma of Japan in NESOG National Conference. This award is decided at the National Conference and is conferred upon during International NESOG Conference. The awardee has to present his/her paper in the forth-coming international conference and the award is conferred during inaugural ceremony of the International NESOG Conference. The awardees get a certificate from the society and gift from Prof. H Soma. Since 2007 a cash prize of Rupees Five Thousands (NRs 5000) is awarded in place of gift from Prof. Soma.

2. NESOG Award

NESOG Award started in the year 2000, carries a certificate and a cash prize of five thousand rupees (Nrs 5000/) to the awardee. This award is decided at the National Conference and is conferred upon during International NESOG Conference. The awardee has to present his/her paper in the forth-coming International Conference and the award is conferred during inaugural ceremony of the International Conference.

3. Lifetime Achievement Award to Honor to Senior Obstetricians and Gynecologists

Two senior-most Nepali Obstetricians and Gynecologists are awarded with Senior Obstetrician and Gynecologist Honor in every national conference of NESOG. They are awarded in the inaugural ceremony of the conference with a **Tamrapatra and a certificate** from the society for their life-long dedication and valuable contribution in providing quality reproductive health services to Nepalese women.

AWARD SUPPORTED BY OTHER SOCIETIES

1. **FIGO Awards:** FIGO Awards in Recognition of Women Obstetrician/ Gynecologists are awarded to nominees from member societies during FIGO Congress.
2. **Fellowships** are awarded to nominees from member societies to attend world congress of FIGO. FIGO/ Chien- Tien Hsu Fellowship in Gynecologic Oncology is also awarded to Gynecologists of member societies periodically.
3. **YGA / AOFOG Award**

S S Ratnam - Young Gynaecologist Award (SSR - YGA)- The SSR - YGA is conferred to promising young Obstetricians and Gynecologists from all the member countries of the Asia and Oceania region including Nepal; providing the opportunity to participate in the congress of the Asia Ocenia

Federation of Obstetrics and Gynecology (AFOG) which are usually held biennially. Many Young Nepali Gynecologists have also benefitted from this.
